
Medley: I Love Coffee, I Love Tea and Knuckles

This traditional piano piece has been a family favorite for many, many years! The duet has three catchy tunes on higher keys, all that finish with the same ending pattern. First learn by rote (copying your teacher or the YouTube tutorials). Next, use this sheet to remind you of the patterns. Once you know the piece, teach it to someone you know who isn't in piano lessons!

Coffee, Tea Ending Pattern

First learn this ending pattern. It finishes each of the three following tunes, first in the middle of the piano, then an octave higher each time.





Pentatonic Black Keys


Begin with two black keys, and play RH finger 3 up the black keys. Turn around on a higher set of two black keys and then play back down again. Play ending pattern.






Knuckles

Make a loose, comfortable fist with your RH. Play each wrist roll then land with your side wrist on the nearest black key in the direction of the roll. Play ending pattern.







I Love Coffee, I Love Tea

Higher on the piano play black-white-black patterns one then two, black-only pattern three, and finish with the ending pattern.
